 and entered into this 14th day of May 1870 between
 Emanuel Punter debtor of the first part, and
 James Adams Creditor of the 2nd part, Witnesseth:
 That whereas the said party of the first part is
 justly indebted to the party of the 2nd part in
 the sum of fifty dollars and by a promissory
 note and payable on or before the 14th day of
 November 1870 and the said party of 1st part
 being desirous to secure the payment of said
 indebtedness; for and in consideration thereof
 and for the further consideration of the sum
 of one dollar to the said party of the said
 party of the 1st part in hand paid by the said
 party of the 2nd part receipt whereof is hereby
 acknowledged, the said party of the 1st part has
 sold and hereby sells & conveys to the said party
 of the 2nd part the following described property
 to wit: on all the Cotton Corn & potatoes to be
 raised by said Punter on the farms which
 he is now cultivating the note assigned to be
 necessary there presents being for order
 to enable said Emanuel Punter to make a
 crop to have and to hold in trust, as follows:
 It is hereby agreed that the said party of the 1st
 part is to have and retain possession of the
 said property until the 14th day of November 1870
 and if the said party of the 1st part shall fully pay
 to the said party of the 2nd part said debt with in-
 terest thereon and reasonable expenses hereof
 by said 14th day of November 1870 then this indenture
 is to be void. But upon default of

Such payment the said party of the second part is hereby authorized to take into possession and sell said property to the highest bidder for cash. After giving ten days notice of the time and place of said sale by publication in a newspaper if one published in the County or by posting at three public places, and out of the proceeds of said sale retain the sum of Fifty Dollars and interest thereon and the reasonable costs hereof and the balance if any pay to the said party of the first part, Signed Seal & delivered this
