Know all men by these presents that I Frank J. Smith of the Parish of Bossier in the State of Louisiana for and in consideration of the sum of one dollar to me in hand paid by Reuben S. Edwards, the receipt whereof I do hereby acknowledge, and in obedience to the award and decision of John T. Melier and George H. Gilmer Arbitrators to whom was referred the matter of a partition of certain lands lying in Jefferson and Shelby Counties in the State of Alabama, jointly owned by the grantor and grantee in this deed and William P. Chittin Jack Thornton, George H. Gilmer Presley M. Donaldson and Alfred H. Moore which said award and decision were made on the 11th day

of May 1870 have bargained sold and quit claimed
and by these presents do bargain, sell and quit
claim unto the said Isabelle S. Edwards, her
heirs and assigns forever all my right, title
interest claim and demand both at law and
in equity, and as well in possession as in
expectancy of in and to the following described
lands situated in Jefferson and Shelby Coun-
ties in the State of Alabama to wit:

The East half of the North East quarter and first
sixth off of the Eastern side of the North East quarter
of the South East quarter of Section Twelve.

Township Eighteen of Range three West. Containing
one hundred and thirteen 53/100 Acres more
or less. The North East quarter of the North East
quarter of Section Eight, the North half of
North West quarter and the South East quarter
of the North West quarter the North East quarter
of the South West quarter the North East quarter
of the South East quarter and the east half of
the South East quarter of Section twenty two.
All in Township twenty of Range three West.

Containing one hundred and twenty
Acres more or less, the South west quarter
of the South West quarter and then fourths off
of the western side of the South East quarter
of the South West quarter of Section twenty
Eight in Township nineteen of Range three West
Containing twenty Acres more or less
- which said lands are a portion being
one sixth of the aforesaid lands formerly held
by the grantors and grantee in this deed
and William P. Chilton Jack Thornton,
George H. Gilman Resley W. Donaldson and
Alfred H. Moore set apart to the said Isabelle
S. Edwards,
