 son debtor of the first part and Samuel
 Wilson creditors of the 2nd part witnesses
 That whereas the said party of the first part
 is jointly indebted to the party of the 2nd part
 in the sum of fifty dollars due by agreement
 in 1878 and payable on or before the 1st day
 of November 1878 and the said party of the 1st
 part being desirous to secure the payment
 of said indebtedness: for and in consideration
 thereof and for the further consideration of the
 sum of one dollar to the said party of the
 1st part in hand paid by the said party of the
 2nd part. receipt whereof is hereby acknowl-
 edged the said party of the 1st part has sold
 and hereby sells and conveys to the said
 party of the 2nd part the following described
 property to wit: All the Crop Corn and Cotton
 to be raised by him this year (1878) to have
 and to hold, in trust as follows: It is hereby
 agreed that the said party of the 1st part is to

have and retain possession of the said property until the 1st day of November 1878 and if the said party of the 1st part shall fully pay to the said party of the 2^d part said debt with interest thereon and reasonable expenses hereof by said 1st day of November 1878 then this instrument is to be null and void. But upon default of such payment the said party of the second part is hereby authorized to take into possession and sell said property to the highest bidder for cash. After giving Ten days notice of the time and place of said sale by publication in a newspaper of the published in the County, or by posting at the public places and out of the proceeds of said sale retain the sum of fifty dollars and interest thereon and the reasonable costs hereof, and the balance if any pay to the said party of the first part.
