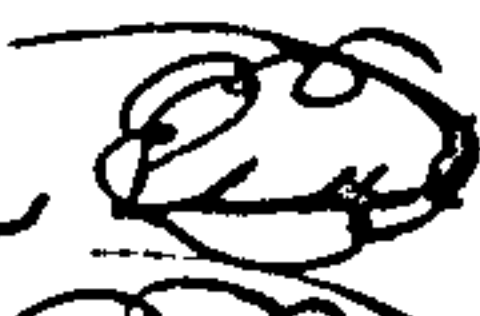
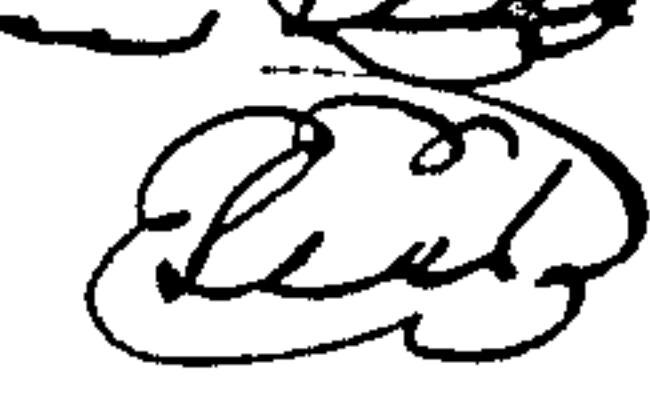

This Indenture made and entered into this 18th day of July 1878 between Geo. Farr Attoro of the first part and Demmond & Mason Creditors of the 2nd part Containeth: That whereas the said party of the first part is justly indebted to the party of the 2nd part in the sum of one thousand dollars due by A/c on 1878 and payable on or before the 1st day of Nov 1878 and the said party of 1st part being desirous to secure the payment of said indebtedness for and in Consideration thereof, and for the further Consideration of the sum of one dollar, to the said party of the 1st part, in hand paid by the said of the 2nd part, receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, the said party of the 1st part has sold, and hereby does convey to the said party of the 2nd part, the following described property, to wit: All the Crop Corn & Cotton to be Raised by or on my Mother's Place All the Crop is now to have and to have, in Trust, as follows: It is hereby agreed that the said party of the 1st part is to have and retain possession of the said property until the 1 day of Nov 1878 and if the said party of the 1st part shall fully pay to the said party of the 2nd part said debt with interest thereon and reasonable Expense hereof, by said 1 day of Nov 1878 then this indenture is to be void, But upon default of such payment the said party of the 2nd part is hereby authorized to take into possession and sell said property to the highest bidder, for cash after giving Ten days notice of the time and place of said sale by publication in a Newspaper if one published in the County, or by posting at three public places, and out of the proceeds of said sale retain the sum of one thousand dollars and interest thereon and the reasonable Costs hereof, and the balance if any pay to the said party of the first part.
