sideration received to my full Satisfaction of
my wife Amelia Cook, of the State and County
aforesaid have given granted, bargained, sold
and conveyed and forever quitclaimed and
do hereby by these presents, give, grant, bargain
sell, convey and forever quitclaim unto the
said Amelia Cook her heirs and assigns the
following designated and described tract of land
to wit: All that portion of the West half (W¹/₂) of the North
East Quarter (N¹/₄) of Section Twenty-two (22) Township
(22) Twenty-two Range Two (2) West lying South of the
right of way of the Helena Rome and Dalton Railroad
As called with the Exception of Twenty (20) Acres
situated in the East part thereof, which I hereby
reserve for my own proper use and behoof and
to which my wife, the said Amelia Cook, has
relinquished her claim interest by deed of
Evan Rute herewith; the tract by these presents
conveyed by me to my wife, the said Amelia
Cook, being situated in the State and
County aforesaid in the District of land formerly
subject to sale at the land office of Tuscaloosa
and containing as is supposed about fifty
Acres, To have and to hold unto the said

Solomon Cook her heirs and assigns forever together with all and singular the improvements and appurtenances thereto belonging so that neither the said Solomon Cook nor my heirs nor any other person or persons claiming title or interest under and through him shall or will claim or demand any right, title or interest in the premises described or any part thereof, other than I or they, and lawfully and equitably entitled to under the reservation aforesaid, but they all and every one, and shall be forever barred.
