granted, remised, released and forever quit-
claimed, and do by these presents give, grant,
remise, release and forever quit-claim unto
the said Shelby Lumber Company, its legal representatives
and assigns forever all such right, title and
interest - and all such privileges and immunities
as are vested in us or either of us; or are by us

or either of us possessed in. to. under or upon
 the following designated and described
 lands to wit: the South East $\frac{1}{4}$ of the South East $\frac{1}{4}$
 of Section 9, and the South West $\frac{1}{4}$ of the South West $\frac{1}{4}$
 and the East $\frac{1}{2}$ of the South East $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 10, the
 South $\frac{1}{2}$ of the South West $\frac{1}{4}$ and the South East $\frac{1}{4}$
 of the South East $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 11 the North $\frac{1}{2}$ and
 the East $\frac{1}{2}$ of the South West $\frac{1}{4}$ and the West $\frac{1}{2}$ of
 the South East $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 14, the South East $\frac{1}{4}$
 and the East $\frac{1}{2}$ of the South West $\frac{1}{4}$ and the South $\frac{1}{2}$

 North West $\frac{1}{4}$ and that portion of the West $\frac{1}{2}$
 of the North East $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 22, situated North
 of the said S. R. & D. Railroad, the East $\frac{1}{4}$ and
 the North East $\frac{1}{4}$ of the North West $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 23
 all in Township 22 Range 2 West. Also the North
 West $\frac{1}{4}$ of the North West $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 1, the East $\frac{1}{2}$
 of the North East $\frac{1}{4}$ and the North West $\frac{1}{4}$ of the North
 East $\frac{1}{4}$ and the North East $\frac{1}{4}$ of the North West $\frac{1}{4}$ and

 North West $\frac{1}{4}$ of said above mentioned Section 5
 in Township 24 Range 13 East from one portion
 of his or their adjoining lands to another. And
 the Selma Rome and Dalton Railroad provided
 that this right shall be so exercised as to cause
 as little inconvenience to the said Shelby Linn Company

its successors and assigns as practicable con-
sistent with the free enjoyment of said reserved
rights and privileges.] Also the storn, wood
and timber, being and to be in, upon and
under the following designated and described
tracts of land to wit: the East $\frac{1}{2}$ of the North West
and the West $\frac{1}{2}$ of the North East $\frac{1}{4}$ and the South
East $\frac{1}{4}$ of the North East $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 24 and the
South East fractional $\frac{1}{4}$ of said Section 24
Township 22 Range 3 West. Excepting therefrom
forty acres in the Eastern end, formerly belonging
to Abram Butler; with the exceptions of such ser-
vations as are set forth and stipulated in an
indenture and agreement dated July 30th 1857
made and entered into by and between Cyril
W. Gardner and John W. Papley of the first part
and Lemuel J. Hall and John C. Kenna of the second
part and recorded Book 2nd 1859 pages 185 to 187
Book 10 in the office of the Probate Judge of Shelby
County; the storn and timber only being and
to be in and upon said lands, in said Section
24 Township 22 Range 3 West, being conveyed heretofore
or by these presents to the said Shelby Lumber Company
to have and to hold the land and property
above set forth and described unto the said
Shelby Lumber Company and to its legal repre-
sentatives and assigns forever; so that neither the
the said Lemuel J. Hall and Martha A. Hall, his
wife nor our heirs, nor any other person or persons
claiming title or interest under us or through us
shall or will claim or demand any right title
or interest in the premises described or any
part thereof, other than we are lawfully and
equitably entitled to under the reservations and
stipulations aforesaid; but they all and every
one and all shall be by these presents forever
barred. And Witness, whereof, we the said Lemuel
J. Hall and Martha A. Hall have hereunto set
our hands and seals this thirtieth (30) day of July
in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred
and seventy,
