of the State and County aforesaid - having given
Grounded, remised, released and forever quit-
claimed, and do by these presents give, grant,
remise, release and forever quit - claim unto
the said Shelby Lime Company, its legal representatives
and assigns forever all such right, title and
interest - and all such privileges and immunitie
as are vested in me or either of us; or are by me

or either of us possessed in, to, under or upon
 the following designated and described
 lands tract, the South East $\frac{1}{4}$ of the South East $\frac{1}{4}$
 of Section 9, and the South west $\frac{1}{4}$ of the South west $\frac{1}{4}$
 and the South $\frac{1}{2}$ of the South East $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 10, the
 South $\frac{1}{2}$ of the South West $\frac{1}{4}$, and the South east $\frac{1}{4}$
 of the South East $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 11, the North $\frac{1}{2}$ and
 the East $\frac{1}{2}$ of the South west $\frac{1}{4}$ and the West $\frac{1}{2}$ of
 the South East $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 14, the South East $\frac{1}{4}$

 of the North East $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 22, situated south
 of the said S. R. & D. Railroad, the Great $\frac{1}{4}$ and
 the North East $\frac{1}{4}$ of the North West $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 23
 see in Township 22 Range 2 West, also the North
 West $\frac{1}{4}$ of the North West $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 1, the East $\frac{1}{2}$

 of his or their adjoining lands to another. And
 the Levisa Rome and Dalton Railroad provided
 that this right shall be so exercised as to cause
 as little inconvenience to the said Shelly Lemon Company

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its successors and assigns as trustee, con-
sistent with the free enjoyment of said reserved
rights and franchises, to all the stone, wood
and timber, being and to be in, upon and
under the following described and described
tracts of land, to wit: the East $\frac{1}{2}$ of the North West
and the West $\frac{1}{4}$ of the North East $\frac{1}{4}$ and the South
East $\frac{1}{4}$ of the North East $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 24 and the
South East fractional $\frac{1}{4}$ of said Section 24
Township 22 Range 3 West. Excepting therefore
forty acres in the East end, formerly belonging
to Herman Bissell; with the exception of such reser-
vations as are set forth and stipulated in an
indenture and agreement dated July 30th 1855
made and entered into by and between Cyril
W. Gardner and John W. Gaspel of the first part
and Lemuel J. Hale and John C. Remond of the second
part and recorded at Port J. 1859 pages 188 to 189
Book H. A. in the office of the Probate Judge of Shelby
County, the stone and timber only being and
to be in and upon said lands, in said Section
24 Township 22 Range 3 West, being conveyed hereby
or by these presents to the said Shelby Lime Company
to have and to hold the land and property
above set forth and described unto the said
Shelby Lime Company and to its legal repre-
sentatives and assigns forever so that neither can
the said Lemuel J. Hale and Martha A. Hale his
wife nor our heirs nor any other person or persons
claiming title or interest under us or through us
shall or will claim or demand any right title
or interest in the premises described or any
part thereof, other than we are lawfully and
equitably entitled to under the reservations and
stipulations aforesaid; but they all and every
one are and shall be by these presents forever
bound, 't'w witness, whereof, we the said Lemuel
J. Hale and Martha A. Hale have hereunto set
our hands and seals this thirteenth (30) day of July
in the year of our Lord One thousand eight hundred
and seventy,
