 grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said party
 of the second part the following described land
 lying in Shelby County Alabama $\frac{1}{2}$ of $\frac{1}{4}$ of
 $\frac{1}{4}$ and $\frac{1}{2}$ of $\frac{1}{4}$ of $\frac{1}{4}$ all in Section thirteen
 Township 21 Range 2 East containing forty acres
 more or less to have and to hold to said
 second party their heirs and assigns forever the
 above described and hereby granted lands
 and premises, And the said parties of the first

part. husband & wife hereby Covenant with the
 Said party of the Second part that they are
 lawfully seized of, and have a good right to sell
 and convey said land and hereby bind them-
 selves, their heirs and legal representatives forever
 to warrant and defend the title to said land
 and premises to the Said party of the Second
 part their heirs, assigns and legal representatives
 against the claim of all and every person in
 law or equity, and against the Government of the
