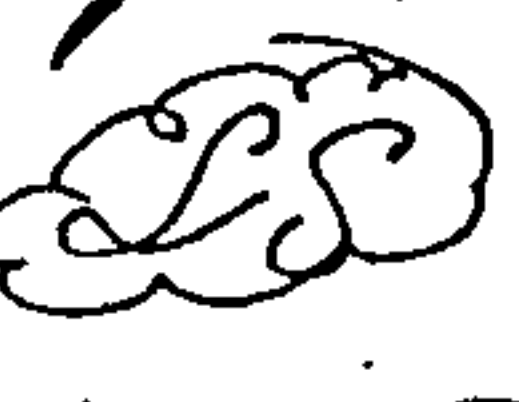

 do hereby acknowledge - do hereby grant bargain
 sell convey & confirm unto the said Thomas
 J. Garrison the following designated tracts
 or parcels of land to wit The North East quarter
 Sec 12 - the South East quarter of the South East
 of Sec 10 - the East half of a North West quarter of
 Section 12 - the North East quarter of South West
 of Section 12 - the North West quarter of the SW $1/4$
 of Section 12 - & $1/2$ of SE $1/4$ of Sec 12 - All in
 Township 24. of Range 14 East. Also the North
 West quarter of SW $1/4$ of Sec 7 of Township 24 of Range
 fifteen East. Containing 470. $51/4/100$ acres more
 or less. To Have and to hold the foregoing
 premises to the said Thomas J. Garrison his
 heirs and assigns to their use and behoof forever
 And we do Covenant with the said Thomas J.
 Garrison his heirs and assigns, that we are
 lawfully seized in fee of the foregoing premises
 that they are free from all Encumbrances; that
 we have a good right to sell and convey the same
 to the said Thomas J. Garrison his heirs and
 assigns and that we will warrant and defend
 the premises to the said Thomas J. Garrison his
 heirs and assigns forever, against the lawful claims
 and demands of all persons.
