 To Shreve County and Entered into this 14th
 Hugh Stinson day of January 1871 between Emanuel Wick
 & John Farr as parties of the first part and Hugh Stinson
 and John Farr as parties of the second part
 All of the County and State aforesaid Witnesseth
 That whereas the said parties of the first part
 this day procured the signatures of the parties
 of the second part to two Bonds for his
 appearance at the next Term of the Circuit
 Court one to answer to the charge of an
 assault with intent to commit Murder and
 the other for adultery the first mentioned
 for \$200.00 and the other for \$50.00 and
 the said parties of the first part being desirous
 to protect the said parties of the second part
 from loss or damage on account of their
 becoming his securities upon said Bond
 for and in consideration thereof and
 for the further consideration of the sum
 of one dollar to the said parties of the first
 part in hand paid the receipt whereof is hereby
 acknowledged the said parties of the first part
 has sold and hereby sells and conveys to the
 said parties of the second part the following property
 to wit: The West 1/2 of the NW 1/4 of Section 20 and the E 1/2
 of the NW 1/4 of Section 19. All in Township 20 Range 1
 East and this horse wagon three cows some
 Calf and eighteen head of stock Hogs also
 Fifty bushels of Corn and Ten Hens of Poultry 1 set
 of blacksmith tools to have and to hold in trust
 as follows this hereby agreed that the said
 parties of the 1st part is to have and retain pos-
 session of the said property until default is
 made upon either or both of said Bonds
 and the said parties of the second part made
 under them than the said parties of the
 second part or either of them is hereby

authorized to take into their possession and sell said property to the highest bidder for cash after giving thirty days notice of the time and place of said sale by posting up notices at the Court House door and three other public places and out of the proceeds of said sale pay off the liabilities that may have accrued against them as Securities aforesaid and all costs and the expenses hereof and the balance if any pay to the said parties of the first part.
