 Range 15 East, and the party of the
 first part hereby gives grants and
 secures to the party of the second part
 the privilege and right without hin-
 drance or molestation to enter upon
 said above described land and cut
 down sever and remove said more
 and timber on fifty Acres of land.

 and agrees with the party of the second
 part to secure to them their heirs
 and assigns the above described more
 and timber on fifty Acres land -
