Harmond occurs by a promissory note
 of this date and payable on the 15th day
 of December 1871 which indebtedness the
 said party of the first part is anxious
 to secure to the party of the second part
 Therefore the party of the first part has
 given granted, bargained & sold and
 by these presents does give, grant, bargain
 & sell unto the party of the second part
 The foregoing personal property to wit:
 One Bay mare named Molly, three
 yearlings and about twelve year
 old some yoke of Oxen one pair red
 & white spotted, the other dark headed
 ends of horns off now in the possession
 of said Frank Williamson said Steers
 about six or seven years old. To have & to hold
 the same upon trust nevertheless until
 default be made in the payment of
 the aforesaid debts as above described
 & it is hereby agreed and understood by
 & between the parties that the said party
 of the first part is to retain the joint & several
 possession of the property aforesaid until
 the 15th day of December 1871 Then if the debt
 aforesaid is not fully paid & satisfied to
 said party of the second part he may sell
 said property, & after advertising Twenty
 days in some public place proceed &
 sell said property or a sufficiency thereof
 to pay said debt and cost to the highest bidder
 for cash & out of the proceeds of the sale pay
 & satisfy said debts & costs thereon and
 the balance if any pay over to the party
 of the first part or his legal representatives
 but should the whole of said debt & costs
 be fully paid by the fifteenth day of Decem-
 ber 1871 then this deed of trust shall void
 & of full force & effect.
