Made and entered into this 28th day of December
1870 between R. G. Taylor debtor of the
first part and Jesse Taylor creditor, of the
2nd part. Witnesseth: That whereas the said
party of the first part is justly indebted &
to the party of the 2nd part in the sum of
One hundred Sixty Two dollars, due by
Promissory note and payable on or before
the 25th day of December 1871 and the said
party of 1st part being desirous to secure
the payment of said indebtedness for and
in consideration thereof, and for the further
consideration of the sum of one dollar to the
said party of the 1st part, in hand paid by the
said party of the 2nd part, receipt whereof is
hereby acknowledged, the said party of the
1st part has sold and hereby sells & conveys
to the said party of the 2nd part the following
described property, to wit: One Bay Horse
three years old to have and to hold in trust
as follows: It is hereby agreed that the
said party of the 1st part is to have and
retain possession of the said property
until the Twenty fifth day of Dec 1871 and
if the said party of the 1st part shall fully
pay to the said party of the 2nd part said
debt with interest thereon and reasonable
expenses hereof, by said 25th day of Dec 1871
then this indenture is to be null & void
But upon default of such payment the said
party of the second part is hereby authorized
to take into possession and sell said
property to the highest bidder for cash

This deed of trust is satisfied in full

August 17th 1871

after giving Ten days notice of the time and place of said sale by publication in a newspaper if one published in the County or by posting at three public places, and out of the proceeds of said sale retain the sum of One hundred & Sixty Two Dollars and balance if any pay to the said party of the first part.
