And consideration of the payment by O. M. Edwards to W. A. Street Attorney for E. A. Reinhardt for me now my indebtedness to said Reinhardt of the Sum of Two hundred dollars. I have sold & delivered to said Edwards in part payment of the Sum one hundred dollars in a Marble Slab. bark Mill. Tannery Tools &c &c And now owe to said Edwards one hundred dollars which I am to pay & discharge in work & labor for the said Edwards at & about his Tannery or tan yard. which he said Edwards is now about to establish & put in operation for the purpose of tanning hides into leather near Columbus which ever called on or required to do so, by said Edwards, during the year 1871 or until the work & labor at the price therefor as may be reasonable right. Shall fully pay & discharge this obligation. It being understood that the work & labor is to be done & performed, when required by said Edwards, and for such length of time only, when required as said Edwards may direct from time to time to put said Edwards tan yard in operation & in working the same I am to accept such instructions to do said Edwards or his Son, or assistant as I may be capable of, from my knowledge of the Trade or business of tanning leather and in consideration of the premises, advancing said money for me, and assenting to its repayment as above stated. I further obligate & bind myself to carry the tanning business at my tan yard in or near Columbus. So soon as my present stock & wood is worked out until the said Edwards is fully paid, and satisfied, by my work & labor & superintendence of his tan yard as contemplated & understood by this obligation, and to secure the due performance of this obligation on the ultimate payment to said Edwards of the said Sum of One hundred dollars, I hereby bargain & convey to him my tan yard & lot & parcel of land in or near Columbus, the same conveyed to me on the 31st day of January 1871 by E. A. Reinhardt the conveyance to which with this obligation turned over to said Edwards & with the distinct understanding & agreement that should I fail, or neglect to perform said work & labor as contemplated, when & as required by

Said Edward he may proceed to sell my said
 ten yard lot parcel of land, to the highest bidder
 for Cash at public sale, at ten days notice
 at two or more public places in said County
 and whosoever does him on account of my
 said failure or neglect, petition by him, the
 balance pay me - but should & as contemplated
 in all things comply with this my obligation the
 said deed from Ackworth to be returned to
 me & this obligation cancelled by said Edward
 as witness my hand & seal this 4th day of Feb 1871
