 and convey unto said Lucy Farr the following
 described Real Estate to wit, the West 1/2 of the
 North East 1/4 of Section 28 and the South West 1/4
 of the South East quarter of Section 21 all in
 Township 20 Range one East also the NE 1/4 of
 the NW 1/4 & the SE 1/4 of the NW 1/4 of Section 28 Town-
 ship 20 Range one East lying and being situate in
 said County of Shelby to have and to hold
 said lands unto the said Lucy Farr her heirs
 & assigns forever together with the appurtenances
 and hereditaments thereto belonging or in
 any way appertaining and I will hereby warrant
 and defend the title to said Lucy Farr to said
 lands against the claims or claims of all
 persons lawfully claiming the same -
