between Mrs Rebecca H. Simpson of the first
part & Saml. J. Hamel of the second part
Witneth That for and Consideration of the
Sum of Eight hundred dollars to me in
hand paid by said party of the second
part the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged
I have bargained sold & conveyed & by these
presents doth bargain sell & convey
unto the said party of the second part the
following described tract of land or parcel of
land to wit The west half of the South west
Quarter of Section Twelve Township Twenty
two Range then West containing Eighty one
more or less & in the Truscloved Land dis-
trict together with all and singular the
appurtenances thereto belonging & the said
party of the first part for herself her heirs Ex-
ecutors Administrators & assigns Warrant
void forever defend the title to the same
unto the party of the second part his heirs
Executors Administrators & assigns forever
against all & every person or persons whom
also against all Claims against the
Government of the United States & the testimony
whereof I said party of first part hereto
set my hand & affixed my seal this the seventh
day of February in the year of our Lord
one thousand Eight hundred & forty one
