The State of Arkansas. This Indenture made and
 Shelo County, & entered into this 17 day of
 February 1871 between James G. Harris debtor
 of the first part, and H. R. Symmes Creditor of the
 2nd part. Witnesseth: That whereas the said party
 of the first part is justly indebted to the party of
 the 2nd part in the sum of one Hundred Twenty
 five dollars due by note and payable on or
 before the 1st day of November, 1871 and the said
 party of 1st part being desirous to secure the
 payment of said indebtedness; for and in con-
 sideration thereof, and for the further con-
 sideration of the sum of one dollar to the said
 said party of the 1st part, in hand paid by the
 said party of the 2nd part, receipt whereof is hereby
 acknowledged, the said party of the 1st part has
 sold, and hereby sells and conveys to the said
 party of the 2nd part, the following described prop-
 erty to wit: Three Bales Cotton weighing five
 Hundred pounds, each to be planted and
 grown by and the present year in the plantation

belonging to the Estate of M. P. Brown & Co. Sherry
County, Ohio to have and to hold in Trust as
follows: It is hereby agreed that the said party
of the 1st part is to have and retain possession
of the said property until the 1st day of November
1871 and if the said party of the 1st part shall fully
pay to the said party of the 2nd part said debt with
interest thereon and reasonable expenses hereof
by said 1st day of November 1871 then this in-
strument is to be null and void. But upon
default of such payment the said party of the
second part is hereby authorized to take into
possession and sell said property to the
highest bidder for cash after giving fifteen
days notice of the time and place of said sale
by publication in a newspaper if one published
in the County, or by posting at three public
places and out of the proceeds of said sale retain
the sum of One Thousand & Twenty five dollars
and interest thereon and the reasonable costs
and the balance of any pay to the said party
of the first part.
