 Mr Elizabeth Thompson of said County for and
 in consideration of the natural love and
 Affection which I have and bear for my
 daughter, Elizabeth Thompson and also for valuable
 services rendered me for several years while
 on my bed of Affliction and her promise that
 she will continue to serve me in any and
 Every way in her power for my comfort during
 the remainder of my natural life, as well as one
 dollar to me in hand paid by said daughter
 the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged
 hereby given, grant bargain, and sell and
 convey to my said daughter an undivided
 half interest in the following described lands
 and certain premises lying in said State and
 County, and known as the Robert Thompson
 place, and more particularly described as
 follows: The NW 1/4 of Section 22, Township 19
 Range 2 East, all of said greater Section except
 about eleven acres off of the NW corner of the West 2
 and one (1) acre off of the East 1/2 of said greater Section
 which was heretofore deeded to Jesse A. Collins
 Also a strip off of SW corner of the NW 1/2 of the
 SE 1/4 of said greater Section of about five
 acres more or less, to have and to hold unto
 the said Elizabeth Thompson, her heirs assigns and
 legal representatives forever, and I do for myself
 my heirs and legal representatives Covenant
 to and with the said Elizabeth Thompson that

I am lawfully seized of said lands and have a good right to sell and convey the same as above and that I will forever warrant and defend the title to said half interest in said land. Said half interest to include the dwelling house in which we now live both in law and equity, against any and all claims whatsoever. And testimony whereof I have hereunto signed my name and affixed my seal this 1st day of April 1871
