part both of the County & State aforesaid
witnesseth that the said party of the second
part hath this day sold unto the party of
the first part a certain Mule about nine
years old for one hundred and forty
dollars due the 15th day of December next and
the said party of the first part is to give
the said party of the second part a sum on
said mule and all of his entire crop of corn
and cotton that he may make for the present
year and the said party of the first part
is to cultivate said crop well and gather
the same in good time and to take good

Care of said Mower and not to remove any
of said crop off the premises until said
debt is paid or with out the leave of the said
party of the second part and when said
debt falls due if the party of the first part
fails to pay the same it shall be lawful

and take the same for cash or a sufficient
amount to pay said debt and costs of this
trust giving ten days notice of the time
and place of said sale and after selling
the same should then remain in the
hands of the party of the second part over
and above what will pay said debt & costs
he shall pay it over to the party of the
first part,
