 and before the sealing and delivery of these  
 presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged  
 the said John T. Wilson and George W. Wilson  
 have granted bargained sold and conveyed  
 and do hereby grant bargain sell and convey  
 to the said A. A. Stuntt and John T. Keeflin  
 and to their heirs and assigns forever all of the  
 following described lots tracts or parcels of land  
 to wit: the north west quarter of the north east  
 quarter of section fourteen in Township twenty  
 four of Range fifteen East the north east quarter  
 of the north east quarter of section eleven in Town-  
 ship twenty four of Range fifteen the north  
 west quarter of the north west quarter of section  
 twelve in Township twenty four of Range fifteen  
 East in Shelby County Alabama To have and to  
 hold the above described and hereby granted  
 lands and premises to the said A. A. Stuntt and the  
 said John T. Keeflin their heirs and assigns forever  
 and the said George W. Wilson and John T. Wilson  
 for themselves their heirs executors and administrators  
 do hereby warrant and will forever defend the  
 title of said lands from and against themselves  
 their heirs executors and administrators, and  
 from and against all other person whomsoever  
 to the said A. A. Stuntt and John T. Keeflin their  
 heirs executors administrators and assigns  
 forever. The testimony whereof the said George
