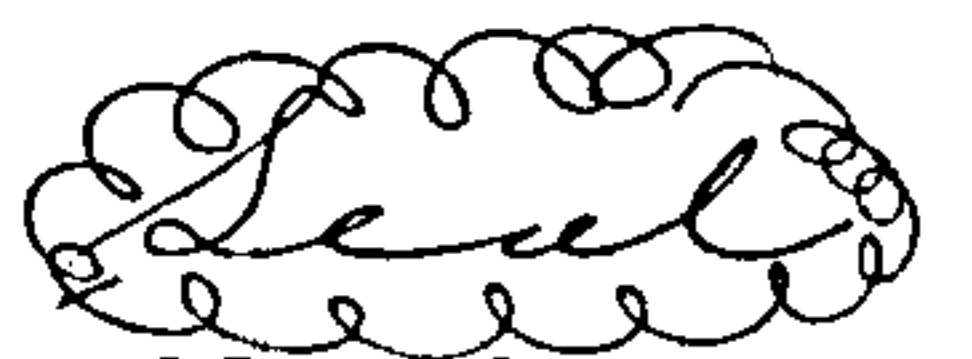
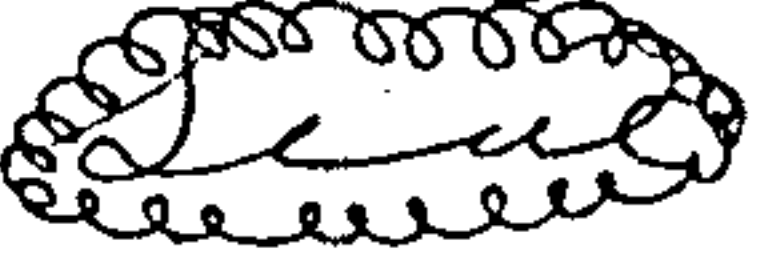

 sold, sealed and delivered unto the said
 John R Farn his heirs and assigns forever
 the following described parcel or tract of Land
 to wit: the South half of the South East quarter of
 Section 28 in Township 20 Range 1 East in
 Shuey County and State of Ala Together.

belonging, to have and to hold unto the
Said John A. Farr, his heirs representatives
and assigns, forever free from the claims
of creditors ours heirs and legal representatives
either in Law or equity - Also writing which
we the said party of the first part hereunto
set our hand and seal the day and date
