 Shelby County, and entered into this
 17th day of March 1871 between Henry H.
 Holsombruck debtor of the first part, and
 Mr. Symmes creditor of the 2nd part, with intent
 That whereas the said party of the first part is
 justly indebted to the party of the 2nd part
 in the sum of Forty dollars, due by note
 and payable on or before the 1st day of
 November 1871 and the said party of 1st part
 being desirous to secure the payment of said
 indebtedness; for and in consideration that

of and for the further consideration of the
sum of one dollar. to the said party of the
1st part. in hand paid by the said party of the
2nd part. receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged
the said party of the 1st part husband and hereby
sells and conveys to the said party of the 2nd
part. the following described property to wit
one Bale Cotton weighing five hundred
pounds. and forty Bushels Corn said Crops
to be planted & grown by me the present year
on plantation belonging to Est of David
Cholmondeley Shelby County Geo to have
and to hold in trust, as follows: It is hereby
agreed that the said party of the 1st part is
to have and retain possession of the said
property until the 1st day of November 1871
and if the said party of the 1st part shall fully
pay to the said party of the 2nd part said debt
with interest thereon and reasonable expenses
hereof. by said 1st day of November 1871 then
this indenture is to be null and void,
But upon default of such payment the said
party of the second part is hereby authorized to
take into possession and sell said property
to the highest bidder for cash. after giving
fifteen days notice of the time and place of said
sale by posting at three public places. and
out of the proceeds of said sale retain the
sum of Forty dollars and interest thereon and
the reasonable costs hereof and the balance of
any pay to the said party of the first day,
