Made this second day of April A.D. 1871
by and between William Allen, party
of the first part and Robert Hall and
John M. Sapsley, party of the second part
witnesseth: The said parties of the first
and second part were joint owners of
several tracts of land in the said
County of Shelby, including the lands
herein specified and certain other
tracts of land specified in a conveyance
from the parties of the second part, to the
party of the first, bearing date April second
A.D. 1871, the date of this indenture; the said
conveyance from the parties of the second
part to the party of the first part, and this
present indenture, being made for the
purpose of partitioning the aforesaid lands
as agreed on by and between the said
William Allen, on the one part and the
said Robert Hall and John M. Sapsley on the
other part, Now in consideration of the
aforesaid conveyance from the parties
of the second part, (the said Hall and Sapsley)
to the party of the first part for the purpose
of partition as aforesaid; and in further

Consideration of the sum of ten dollars
 as well and truly paid by the parties
 of the second part to the party of the first
 part at and before the sealing and
 delivery of this instrument, the said
 party of the first part has granted
 bargained sold and conveyed and
 does by this instrument grant, bargain
 sell and convey to the said parties of the
 second part, and their respective heirs
 and assigns, all his right title and
 interest in and to the herein after
 designated and mentioned tracts
 or parcels of land all situated in the
 State and County aforesaid or in
 the County of Baker and district of
 lands formerly subject to sale in the
 land office of the United States at
 Oregone. That is to say: The west half
 of the North West quarter of Section
 four (4). The East half of the South West
 half of the South West quarter of Section
 four (4). The East half of the North East
 quarter and the North East quarter of the
 South East quarter of Section five (5).
 the North West quarter of the North West
 quarter and the North East quarter of the
 North West quarter of Section nine (9).
 The East half of the South West quarter
 of Section four (4). The North half of the
 North East quarter of Section seven (7).
 The South East quarter of Section eight
 (8) the North West quarter of the South West
 quarter, the South West quarter of the South
 West quarter, the South East quarter of the
 North East quarter, and the North half
 of the South East quarter of the South West
 quarter of Section six (6). all in Township
 twenty four (24) and Range fifteen (15) East,
 (T. 24. R. 15) All fractions. T. 24. R. 15. S. 1. N. 2. E. of
 Section twenty four (24) Township twenty two
 (22) Range one (1) West and the North East
 quarter of the South East quarter of Section
 one (1) in Township twenty four (24)
 Range fourteen (14) East, and Mrs Mary
 H. Allen, wife of the said William Allen
 in consideration of the premises joins
 in the execution of this instrument for

the purpose of conveying and relinquish-
ing to the said Hall and Sapsley their
heirs and assigns as the hereby does her
right of power in and to the lands herein
above specified. This indenture is signed
and sealed by all the parties thereto, and
also signed on the margins of the first
second and third pages by the said William
Allum, Hall and Sapsley for identification.
