for one hundred & fifty five & 3/100 dollars
the receipt whereof his hereby acknowledged
have granted bargained and sold unto
the said party of the second part, and
his heirs representatives and assigns
the following described tract or parcel
of land situated, lying and being in the
State of Alabama & County of Shelby to wit:
The S W 1/4 of the S E 1/4 & W 1/2 of the S E 1/4 of the S E 1/4 of
Section 10 & 2 Township 14 N 21 Range 1 East
To have and to hold said above described
tract or parcel of land with all appurtenances
thereunto belonging unto him the said party
of the second part and unto his heirs and
assigns forever. All Witness whereof we
