County of the one part and Robert E. O'Brien of said County
of the other part witnesses: The said Lucinda Doak for & in
Consideration of the sum of One hundred & fifty dollars
(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) to her in hands
paid by the said Robert E. O'Brien has bargained and
sold and does hereby bargain, sell grant, enfeeoff and
Convey unto the said Robert E. O'Brien the following lands
lying and being in said County & State to wit all
that part and portion of the met 1/2 of NW 1/4 of sec 4 T 24
Range 13 East which lies South of the Selma Rome
& Dalton Rail Road containing about thirty acres more
or less. To have & to hold unto the said Robert E. O'Brien
his heirs and assigns forever together with all the ten-
ements rights & hereditaments therunto belonging or
in any wise appertaining And the said Lucinda Doak
Covenants & agrees to & with the said O'Brien that she is
lawful seized in her demesne as of fee to & in said lands
that the same is free from all incumbrances & she will war-
rant and forever defend the same Given under
her hand & Seal this day & year above written.
