hand paid the receipt whereof is
hereby acknowledged both this day
authorized bargained and sold
and by these presents do bargain
and sell unto the said party Long
the following parcel of land to wit
three acres lying in the south and
of the west half of the south east quarter
of section 11 Township 18 Range one east
the lines to start at the section line
running east and west and run
so as to include the factory shop and
Farmis also Job Falckner dwelling and
out building to have and to hold
all and singular the right title claim
and interest unto the said Long we
further warrant and defend the title
of said land to said Long to his
heirs and assigns and against all
claims of claimants. In testimony
