being in the state and County aforesaid to wit, the west
half of south west fourth and the west half of the north
west fourth of section 18 eight in township 10 north of Range
10 then west containing one hundred and sixty acres and
forty two hundredths to have and to hold as his own prop-
erty in his own right together with all the hereditaments
and appurtenances thereto belonging and they do
for themselves their heirs executors administrators and
assigns forever warrant and defend all right, ti-
tle and Claims of said premises unto the party of
the second part and they do by these presents forever
relinquish unto the party of the second part all right
title Claim and interest in the same, Signed sealed
