 Shelby County I made and enter
 Ed into this 11th day
 of March 1871 between Levi Grenshaw
 debtor of the first part and Duran
 & Nelson Creditors of the second part
 Witnesses; That whereas the said party
 of the first part is justly indebted
 to the party of the second part in the
 sum of one hundred dollars due
 by account for 1870 & 1871 and payable
 on or before the 1 day of Nov 1871
 and the said party of the 1st part
 being desirous to secure the payment
 of said indebtedness: for and in consid-
 eration thereof and for the further con-
 sideration of the sum of one dollar to
 the said party of the 1st part in hand
 paid by the said party of the 2d part
 the receipt whereof is hereby acknow-
 ledged the said party of the 1st part
 has sold and hereby sells and conveys
 to the said party of the 2d part the
 following described property to wit:
 All the Corn and Cotton ^{to be} raised by
 me on my place or else where
 in the year 1871 to have and to hold in
 trust as follows: It is hereby agreed
 that the said party of the 1st part
 is to have and retain possession of the
 said property until 1 day of November
 1871 and if the said party of the 1st
 part shall fully pay to the said party
 of the 2d part said debt with interest
 thereon and the reasonable expenses here-
 of by said 1 day of November 1871 then
 this Indenture to be null and void -
 But upon default of such payment
 the said party of the 2d part is hereby
 authorized to take possession and sell
 said property to the highest bidder
 for cash after giving days notice
 of the time and place of said sale to
~~the said party of the 1st part~~ ^{the said party of the 1st part}
~~pastor up at the following place in~~
~~the County~~ and out of the proceeds
 of said sale retain the said sum

of one hundred dollars and interest thereon and the reasonable costs here of and the balance if any pay to the said party of the 1st part -
