witnessed have sold and thereby sold

confirm and convey unto the said parties of the second part the following described land lying in Shelby County State of Alabama (Subject to sale in the district of Tuscaloosa Ala) to wit - $N\frac{1}{2}$ of $N\frac{1}{4}$, the $SW\frac{1}{4}$ of the $N\frac{1}{4}$ and $SW\frac{1}{4}$ all of section 3 T22 R2 West. the $E\frac{1}{2}$ of $SE\frac{1}{4}$ of section 12 T27 R5-W. Containing three hundred acres more or less to have and to hold to said ~~parties~~ party. their heirs and assigns forever the above described and hereby granted lands and premises and the said parties of the first part - husband and wife hereby Covenant - with the said party of the second part that we are lawfully seized of and have good right to sell and convey said land and hereby bind ourselves our heirs and legal representatives forever to warrant and defend the title to said lands and premises to said party of the second part their heirs ~~and~~ assigns and legal representatives against the claims of all and every person in law or equity and against the Government of the United States given under our hands and seals this day and year above written.
