 Shelby County } and entered into this
 2nd day of November 1871 between John, R.
 Kendrick & and James M. Kendrick debtors
 of the first part, and Daniel McLeod creditor
 of the 2nd part. Witnesseth: That whereas the said
 party of the first part is justly indebted to the
 party of the 2nd part in the sum of One hundred
 and fifty $83\frac{1}{100}$ dollars due by promissory note

bearing even date herewith and payable on or before the 8th day of November 1871 and the said party of 1st part being desirous to secure the payment of said indebtedness; for and in consideration thereof, and for the further consideration of the sum of one dollar, to the said party of the 1st part in hand paid by the said party of the 2nd part, receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, the said party of the 1st part has sold and hereby sells and conveys to the said party of the 2nd part, the following described property, to-wit: One Spotted Horse about eight years old and one

Oregon Colored Horse about five years now in possession of parties of the first part to have and to hold, in trust, as follows also hereby agreed that the said party of the 1st part is to have and retain possession of the said property until the first day of January 1872 and if the said party of the 1st part shall fully pay to the said party of the 2nd part said debt with interest thereon and reasonable expenses hereof by said first day of January 1872 then this indenture is to be null and void. But upon default of such payment the said party of the 2nd part is hereby authorized to take into possession and sell said property to the highest bidder for cash after giving ten days notice of the time and place of said sale by publication in a newspaper of one published in the County, or by posting at three public places, and out of the proceeds of said sale retain the sum of One hundred fifteen $33\frac{1}{3}$ dollars and interest thereon, and the balance if any pay to the said party of the first part.
