 Between R. E. Gamed debtor of the first part
 and John Johnson Creditor of the second part
 witnesseth that whereas the said party of the first
 part is indebted to the party of the second
 part in the sum of One hundred and
 twenty five dollars due by promissory note
 bearing date the 11th day of November 1871 and
 payable on or by the 25th day of December 1872.
 And the said party of the first part being
 desirous of securing the payment of said
 indebtedness for and in consideration
 thereof and for the further sum of One
 dollar to the said party of the first part
 in hand paid by the said party of the
 second part. the receipt whereof is hereby
 acknowledged. the said party of the first
 part has sold and hereby sells & conveys to
 the said party of the second part the following
 described property, (to-wit) A Certain tract or

parcel of Land; East 1/2 of the NE 1/4. the East 1/2 of the SE 1/4. Sec 24 Township 28 Range 2 West. Also a Bay Horse. To have and to hold in trust as follows it is hereby agreed that the said party of the first part is to have and to retain possession of the said property until the 25th day of December 1872 and if the said party of the first part shall fully pay to the said party of the second part said indebtedness with interest thereon and the reasonable expenses here by said 25th day of December 1872 -

Then This indenture to be null and void but upon default of such payment the said party of the second part is hereby authorized to take into possession and sell said property to the highest bidder for Cash. After giving twenty day notice of the time and place of said sale by advertisement posted up at three public places and out of the proceeds of said sale the sum of One hundred and twenty five dollars and interest thereon and reasonable costs here by and the balance if any pay to the said party of the first part Given under my hand and seal this 11th day of November 1871.
