 conveyed, confirmed, and by these presents do grant  
 bargain, sell, alien, remise, release, enfeoff, convey, and  
 confirm to the said party of the second party & his  
 heirs and assigns forever, all and singular the  
 S.W.<sup>1/4</sup> of the S.W.<sup>1/4</sup> of Section Eight Township Twenty  
 two Range and C in Shelby County Alabama

The foregoing described lands were originally subject to entry at the land office at Tuscaloosa Alabama Together with the tenements hereditaments rights immovable franchises and appurtenances unto the above mentioned and described premises belonging or in anywise appertaining to have and to hold the above described premises with the appurtenances unto the said party of the second part his heirs and assigns to the sole and proper use benefit and behoof of the said party of the second part his heirs and assigns forever. And the said John H. Williams and his wife Frances C. Williams for themselves and their heirs the above described and hereby granted and released premises and every part and parcel thereof with the hereditaments appurtenances unto the said party of the second part his heirs and assigns against the said parties of the first part and their heirs and against all and every person and persons whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same shall and will warrant and by these presents forever defend.
