This indenture made and entered in to this
22 day of June 1822 between A N Wilson
of Shelby County of the first part and
J R Smith of the second part all of the
State of Alabama

Witnesseth that whereas the said A. N. Wilson of the first part is justly indebted to James R. Smith in the sum of Twenty five & 7/100 dollars by account ~~of~~ \$2,100 dollars by note dated February 10. 1872 with interest from 1st of Jan 1872 then on the twenty fifth day of December 1872 & signed by M. S. Wilson & A. N. Wilson, & ~~fifteen~~ willing to buy goods and necessaries for self & family during the present year from the said James R. Smith's Store and being desirous to secure the payment of the above described claims and what further sum that may accrue for goods and necessaries during the present year, has this day bargained sold and conveyed to the said James R. Smith his heirs or assigns the following described property to wit: All the Crop of Cotton & now being raised on the place now occupied and worked by said A. N. Wilson known as the Tom Wilson place the said A. N. Wilson binds himself to cultivate said Cotton Crop in a good and farmerlike manner to gather and put up Cotton in good order and deliver the same in Elyton to have and to hold on the following condition and trust: Now if the said A. N. Wilson shall by the twenty fifth day of December next pay off the above described claims to gather with what further sum that may accrue for goods & necessaries during the present year and expenses of this deed then this is to be null void and no effect =

Otherwise the said James R. Smith may as soon thereafter as he may elect and in case of his death his Admors proceed to sell at the Court House door in the town of Columbiana all or as much of said described property for Cash as will satisfy all the above described claims by giving ten days notice by written advertisements posted at the Court House door and two other public places in Shelby County and appropriate to the payment of all the above described claims and the remainder if any to be paid over to the said A. N. Wilson =
