between Edward J. Walker of the first part and  
Ann Walker wife of Said Edward J. Walker of  
the second part witnesseth that whereas above-  
October 1808 the party of the first part received  
from the party of the second part the sum  
of Six Hundred Dollars in Gold the separate  
and sole estate of the said Ann Walker.  
Now in consideration of which and for the nat-  
ural love and affection which the party of  
the first part bear to my said wife: I have this  
day bargained and sold given and granted unto  
my said wife Ann Walker and by these presents  
do give grant - bargain & sell the following described  
land lying and being in the State of Alabama  
County of Shelby and Town of Montevallo viz:  
a certain lot of land known as lot number  
according to the Plat of said town of Mon-  
tvallo fronting on Shelby Street with the depth of  
feet to Main Street bounded on the North  
East by the adjoining premises of Edwin F. West &  
on the South West by the property adjoining  
known as the Campbell property said described  
premises being the property on which the said  
Walker now lives together with all and singular  
the appurtenances tenements and hereditaments there-  
unto belonging to have and to hold the above  
mentioned and described premises with the appur-  
tenances unto the said Ann Walker the <sup>part</sup> ~~property~~  
of the second part her heirs children forever  
And the said party of the first part his  
heirs and assigns will ever warrant and defend

the title and peaceful possession of the above described  
premises as heretofore conveyed -
