in Shelley County & made and entered
A. J. Deshazo into this 5th day of
November 1874 between A. J. Deshazo of the
first part Creditor, and Jasper Lovett
of the second part debtor. Witnesseth
that whereas the said party of the
second part is justly indebted to the
party of the first part in the sum
of Sixty Seven dollars, and fifty cents
due by promissory note, by the first
day of November 1875 and payable
on or before the said 1st Nov 1875, and
the said party of the second part being
desirous to secure the payment of
said indebtedness for and in consider-
ation thereof, and for the further
consideration of the sum of One
dollar to him in hand paid by
said party of the first part, the receipt
whereof is hereby acknowledged, the said
party of the second part has sold and
hath sells and conveys to the party
of the first part, the following

described property viz: One yoke of
Oxen about 4 or 5 years old, and
his intended Crop of the year 1875 to
have and to hold in trust as follows
It is hereby agreed that the said party
of the first part is to have and retain
possession of the said property until
the 1st day of November 1875. And
if the said party of the first part
shall fully pay to the said party of the
first part, said debt and reasonable expenses
thereon by said first day of November
1875 then this indenture is to be null
and void, but upon default of such
payment the said party of the first part
is hereby authorized to take into possession
and sell said property to the highest bidder
for cash, after giving ten days notice
of the time and place of sale, by put-
ting notices in three different places
in the Beet and out of the premises
of said sale retain the sum of \$67.50
and reasonable expenses thereon, and
the balance if any pay to the party
of the second part.
