 A F Johnson of the second part all of the County
 and State aforesaid witnesseth that whereas the said
 party of the first part is justly indebted to the party
 of the second part in the sum of One hundred
 and twenty dollars due the first day of January
 1876 and the said party of the first part being
 willing and desirous to secure the payment of
 the same they do so by giving him a lien on the
 following real estate lying and being in the County
 of Shelley State of Alabama and in the Tuscaloosa
 land district town the South East quarter of the
 Sixth West quarter Section four Township twenty
 Range three west containing forty acres more or
 less now therefore should the said party of the
 first part fail to pay to the said party of the
 second part the above named sum one hundred
 dollars at its maturity it shall be lawful any
 time thereafter for the said party of the second
 part to advertise the above described land in

these public places in the County and sell the same at public outcry for Cash and after selling the same he shall apply the proceeds thereof to the payment of said debt and the expense of this trust and should there remain in the hands of the said party of the second part over and above what will pay the above debt and necessary expenses of this trust he shall pay it over to the party of the first part or their legal representatives.
