State of Alabama, This Indenture made and entered into this 15th
 Shelby County 3 day of Feby 1875 between James C. Wiedeman
 Mahaley Armstrong Haynes Wiedeman and H. J. Armstrong debtors
 of the first part and Thomas B. Miller Creditor of the second part
 witnesseth that whereas the parties of the first part are justly
 indebted to the party of the second part in the sum of One
 hundred and fifty dollars due by a promissory note made
 by said parties of the first part on the 10th day of Feby 1875
 payable to Thos B. Miller or bearer and due the first day
 of Nov 1875 and the said parties of the first being desirous
 to secure the payment of said indebtedness for and in con-
 sideration of the sum of One dollar to the said parties of
 the first part in hand paid by the party of the second
 party receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged the parties
 of the first have sold and hereby bargain sell and
 convey to the party of the second part all of our Cotton Crops
 which we may make this year upon the following con-
 ditions the parties of the first part bind themselves to de-
 liver said Cotton Crops at the Cotton Gin belonging to the party
 of the second part, if the parties of the first part shall fully
 pay to the party of the second part said promissory note with
 interest thereon and the costs hereof by said first day of
 Nov 1875, then this indenture is to be null and void
 But if the parties of the first part shall make default
 of said promissory note with the intent thereof or any
 part thereof, the party of the second part or his agent or
 Attorney is hereby authorized to take into possession and
 sell said Cotton Crops to the highest bidder for cash
 at Highland in said County after giving ten days
 notice in writing of the time and place of said sale
 by posting at Highland and out of the proceeds of
 said sale first pay the cost of this conveyance and then
 balance apply to the payment of said promissory note
 and interest thereon signed sealed and delivered this
 15th day of March 1875.
