 Nissey McDonald Shelby County into this 13 day of July 1878 between
 T. Andrew J. Dodd & Nissey M. Dodd debtors of the first
 part and Henry Milner Creditor of the second part witness
 eth that whereas the said parties of the first part is justly
 indebted to the party of the second part in the sum of
 Twenty three and ⁶⁰/₁₀₀ dollars due by promissory note
 and payable on or before the first day of December next
 and the said parties of the first being desirous to secure
 the payment of said indebtedness for and in con-
 sideration thereof and for the further consideration
 of the sum of One dollar to the said party of the
 first part in hand paid by the said party of the second
 part receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged the said parties

of the first party has sold and Henry sells and conveys to the said party of the second party the following described property to wit One yoke of Steers & Wagons to have and to hold in trust as follows It is Henry agreed that the said party of the first party is to have and retain possession of the said property until the first day of December 1875 And if the said party of the first party shall fully pay to the said party of the second party said debt and interest thereon and reasonable expenses hereof by said first day of December 1875 then this indenture is to be null and void But upon default of such payment the said party of the second party is Henry authorized to take possession and sell said property to the highest bidder for cash after giving ten days notice of the time and place of said sale by posting at two public places and out of the proceeds of said sale retain the sum of Twenty two dollars and Sixty Cents and the reasonable costs Henry and the balance if any pay to the said parties of the first party
