


Nabors Robert State of Alabama, I now all men by these presents that  
To Shelley County I having this day received from John D.  
John D Goode Goode twenty (\$20.00) dollars advanced in one horse  
and having given my note bearing even date with  
this instrument and due on the 1st day of November A.  
D 1876, for said horses with interest from date I Robert  
Nabors do hereby declare that such advance was ob-  
tained by me bona fide for the purpose of making a  
Crop the present year on the plantation of Maj  
Daysoner in Shelley County and that without the

Same it would not be in my power to procure the necessary  
leas to make a Crop, and in Consideration of said ad-  
vance and to secure the same, I hereby grant Bargain Sell  
and Convey to said John D Grode the entire Crop of Cotton  
Corn and fodder which may be produced on said  
plantation the present year, and also the following prop-  
erty to wit: One small Small mare known as the Lure Ben-  
ton Mare. But this Conveyance is upon the following Condition  
if I fully pay said Note together with the expenses of this Con-  
veyance, on or before the said 1st day of November 1876, when  
the same falls due, then this Conveyance to be void, but  
if I fail to pay said Note and expenses in part or in  
whole, when the same falls due then the said John  
D Grode, is authorized to take possession of said property  
above Conveyed or any of it and is also authorized after  
giving two days notice of time and place of sale by no-  
tices in writing posted at two public places in the neigh-  
borhood in said County to sell the same to the highest  
bidder for cash at Elizabethtown in said County and to  
execute titles to the purchaser, and of the proceeds to  
pay 1<sup>st</sup> the expense of signing advertising selling and  
Conveying 2<sup>nd</sup> the amount with interest 3<sup>rd</sup> the expense  
of this Conveyance and lastly shall return any sur-  
plus of said proceeds to the undersigned  
Witness my hand and seal this the 24<sup>th</sup> day of January  
A.D 1876.
