 second part the receipt whereof is hereby acknow-
 ledged, have bargained and sold and by these
 presents do grant bargain, sell and convey unto
 the said parties of the second part, the following de-
 scribed land lying in Shelby County said State;
 to wit, The East $\frac{1}{2}$ of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ & the East $\frac{1}{2}$ of the
 NW $\frac{1}{4}$ & the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 24 Township 21 Range 4
 West, To have and to hold to said second parties
 their heirs and assigns forever, the above described
 and hereby granted lands and premises, And
 the said parties of the first part, husband and
 wife, hereby covenant with the said parties of
 the second part that they are lawfully seized of
 and have a good right to sell and convey
 said land, and hereby bind themselves, their heirs
 and assigns legal representatives forever, to war-
 rant and defend the title to said land and
 premises to the said parties of the second part
 their heirs, assigns and legal representatives ag-
 ainst the claim of all and every person in
 law ~~or~~ equity, and against the Government
 of the United States, Given under our hands &
 seals this day and year above written.
