This Indenture, made and entered into this 9th day
of September A.D. 1874, between Joseph Squire of
said county and state, of the first part and
the Shelby Env company a corporation under the
laws of said state of the second part, witnesseth;
That the said party of the first part for and in
consideration of the sum of Four hundred and
fifty dollars to him in hand paid by the said
party of the second part, the receipt whereof is
hereby acknowledged, has bargained and sold,
and by these presents, does grant, bargain, sell and
convey unto the said party of the second part,

the following described land lying in said county
 & state to wit: The Smith first quarter of the South west
 quarter & the East half of the South west quarter & the
 East half of the North west quarter & the West half of
 the North East quarter & the South East quarter of
 the North East quarter & the East half of the South
 East quarter & the South West quarter of the South East
 quarter, all in Section twenty three of Township
 twenty, in Range two west, containing four
 hundred & forty acres, more or less, and being
 & known as the lands conveyed by James B. Givens,
 & wife to said Joseph Squire, by their deed bearing
 date the 24th day of August 1874 & which were
 conveyed to said Givens by R.C. Russell wife
 to have and to hold to said second party their
 successors and assigns forever, the above described
 and hereby granted lands and premises.
 And the said party of the first part, hereby concur
 with the said party of the second party that he
 is lawfully seized of, and has a good right to
 sell and convey said land and hereby binds
 himself his heirs and legal representatives for
 ever, to warrant and defend the title to said
 and premises to the said party of the second
 party, their successors assigns and legal repre-
 sentatives against the claim of all and every
 person in law or equity, and against the Gov-
 ernment of the United States. Givens under our
