Shelley County } entered into this eighteenth
day of January A.D. 1876
by and between Joseph Squire of the county
aforesaid, party of the first part, and the
Shelley Iron Company a corporation under
the laws of said state party of the second
part, witnesses: That the said party of
the first part for and in consideration of the
sum of twenty two hundred and twenty
five \$225 for dollars to him in hand paid
the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has
bargained and sold, and by these presents does
grant bargain, sell quit claim and convey
to the said party of the second part their
successors assigns, and legal representatives
all his right title ^{interest} claim or demand in and
to the following described land lying in said
county, and known as the North West quarter
of the South East quarter of Section twenty nine
(29) Township twenty one (21) South of Range two
(2) West being the same land conveyed to the
party of the first part by deed of Dr. J. Parker
Trustee for Mary A. Jones dated the (4th) fourth day
of October A.D. 1875, Also the South West quarter
of the South East of Section twenty nine (29) and
the North West quarter of the North East quarter of Section
Thirty two (32) Township twenty one (21) South of Range
two (2) West being the same land conveyed to the
party of the first part, by two deeds one executed
by Irvine Bailey, Caroline E. Bailey, J. O. M. Lendon
and Amanda A. M. Lendon dated the sixteenth day
of September A.D. 1875 the other deed executed
by J. S. Castleberry, A. M. Elliott and D. W. Led-
-well Commissions by virtue of a decree of the
Probate Court of said Shelley County in the
case of Caroline E. Bailey et al vs Lucy C.
Learaway et al dated the fourteenth day
of January A.D. 1876 - In testimony whereof
