 now in case I, E.M. Hernandez fails to pay Sam-
 uel Kelley the amount specified \$2.50 per week
 I forfeit The amount paid on oxen & return
 said oxen to Samuel Kelley in as good fix
 & keeping as when I received them The two
 dollars and fifty cents is to be left in The
 Shelby Iron works office - Now if Mr E.M. Hernandez
 should damage said oxen before returning them
 to Samuel Kelley He is to pay whatsover that should
 be - Now the oxen is to stand good for themselves
 untill paid for, in other words it is agreed that
 the oxen belong to Samuel Kelley untill the full
 amount be paid for them - This 11th day of March /76
