

John S. Poole. State of Alabama, Whereas, Paul H Earle agrees to advance
 and Wm C. Wooten Jefferson County, Ala. to us in necessary provisions, farming
 To tools and implements not to exceed in amount Fifty dollars
 Paul H Earle by the said advances are obtained bona fide for the purpose
 of making a crop, and without such advances it would not
 be in our power to obtain the necessary team, provisions and
 farming implements to make a crop in the year 1877 we
 therefore grant unto Paul H Earle the statutory lien on
 our crop of Cotton and corn grown in the year 1877 in
 Jefferson County, Ala., as provided by Section 1858 of the
 Revised Code of Alabama, And for payment for said advances
 including note we hereby agree to waive all right or
 claim to personal property exemption, secured to us
 under the Constitution and laws of the State of Alabama,

And in order to better secure payment for said advances including note we hereby bargain, sell and convey unto Paul H Earle, his heirs and assigns the following property, to wit a certain small horse mule about fifteen years old also a certain bay mare about thirteen years old, the property of J S Poole. Also a certain red cow the property of W. C. Wooten & fails to pay off said advances and the cost of this deed by the first November 1877 or upon our selling or attempting to sell any of said crops or other property, or moving the same from the limits of Jefferson county, Paul H Earle is authorized to take all of said property into custody, and after giving five days notice by posters in two public places in Jefferson county, to sell the same at Egypt Ala for cash, and with proceeds thereof, pay off for said advances and the cost of this deed. The balance shall be paid to the undersigned.
