 and against any adverse claims - Upon Con-  
 dition, however, that if I pay said account  
 to said Durand & Nelson or their assigns with  
 interest, this deed to be void - but if I should  
 fail to pay said account in whole or in part  
 at maturity, then said Durand & Nelson  
 their Agents or assigns are authorized to  
 take possession of said property, and after  
 giving ten days notice by posting at three  
 public places in the County to sell the same  
 at the Court House to the highest bidder  
 for cash, and the proceeds to devote to the  
 paying 1<sup>st</sup> the Expenses of advertising and  
 selling and 2<sup>d</sup> the amount with interest  
 that may be due thereon, and the surplus  
 if any to be turned over to the under-
