 of Fifty dollars, and for the purpose of securing
 the payment of the same do grant, bargain, sell
 and convey to said Box & Vaudegrift the following
 described personal property, to wit: one black horse
 colt, with white streak down his face and about
 two years old next April, and one Four horse
 wagon, which I got from Peter Deshazor to have
 and to hold to the said Box & Vaudegrift their
 heirs and assigns executed and administrators
 forever, upon condition however that if I pay
 the amount due upon said note above described
 on or before the 25th day of December 1878, when
 the same falls due, together with all legal charges
 that may legally accrue by reason of this instru-
 ment ~~that~~ then this instrument to be void; but
 if I fail to pay said note in full on said 25th
 day of December 1878, together with all legal charg-
 es that may legally accrue by reason of this in-
 strument, then the said Box & Vaudegrift are
 hereby authorized to take possession of said
 property above described and after giving ten
 days notice of the time, terms and place of sale,
 together with a description of said property
 by pasting written notice at the Court house
 door of Shelby County, and three other public
 places in said County of Shelby to, sell the same
 to the highest bidder for cash, at my premises
 or at Brimlyton in said County of Shelby, and to de-
 vote the proceeds of said sale to the payment 1st of the
 expenses of advertising, selling, and all legal charges
 created by reason of this instrument, 2nd of the amount
 with interest that may be due on said note, and
 lastly, if there be any surplus of said proceeds, the
 same is to be returned to the undersigned.
