 1878 and payable Nov 1st 1878, now to secure
 the punctual payment of said indebtedness,
 I do hereby sell and convey to said Duxant &
 Nelson, the following goods and chattels, to wit:
 One horse mare seven years old, one red cow &
 calf, and all the crop of corn & cotton to be raised
 by me or my family in the year 1878,
 warranted free from incumbrance, and against
 any adverse claims, upon condition, however, that
 if I pay said note to said Duxant & Nelson
 or their assigns, with interest, this deed to be
 void; but if I fail to pay said note in whole
 or in part at maturity, then said Duxant &
 Nelson their agents or assigns are authorized to

take possession of said property, and after giving ten days notice by posting at three public places in said county to sell the same at the Court House to the highest bidder, for cash, and the proceeds to devote to the paying of the expenses of advertising and selling, and the amount, with interest, that may be due on said debt, and the surplus, if any, to be turned over to the undersigned, In testimony whereof I hereunto set my hand and affix my seal, on this the 1st day of March 1878
