


Mason Isaac D. The State of Alabama) Do now all make by these presents, That for and

 The receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, we do grant bargain  
 sell and convey unto the said J. R. Browning the following  
 described real estate, to wit: - The N<sup>th</sup>/<sub>2</sub> of Sec 34 & the N<sup>th</sup>/<sub>2</sub> of the  
 S E  $\frac{1}{4}$  & N E  $\frac{1}{4}$  of S E  $\frac{1}{4}$ , & a part of the N E  $\frac{1}{4}$  of the S W  $\frac{1}{4}$  of  
 Sec 34, all in Township 21. R. 1 E containing four hun-  
 dred and seventy acres more or less. To have and to hold  
 to the said J R Browning his heirs and executors forever.  
 And we do for ourselves, heirs, executors, and administrators,  
 covenant with the said J R Browning his heirs and es-  
 signs that we are lawfully seized in fee simple of  
 said premises; that they are free from all incumbrances;  
 and that we have a good right to sell and convey the  
 same as of right; that we will, and that our heirs, executors
