John T. Geronville Jr. Page's Store Alabama March 18th 1878.

To Jas H. Page On the first day of November 1878, I promise to pay to the order of J H Page the sum of Seven ²⁵ ~~25~~ dollars, at his store in Shelby County Ala for value received in necessary provisions, and money to purchase the same, advanced by him to me for the purpose of enabling me to make a crop for the current year. This advance was obtained *bona fide* for the purpose of enabling me to make a crop, and without such advances it would not have been in the power of said John T. Geronville Jr to procure the necessary teams, provisions and farming implements to make a crop the present year. In consideration of which I hereby grant to said J H Page a lien on my crop grown on my plantation in Shelby County Alabama and waive the right of exemption under the laws of Alabama, as provided for in Section 7 Article ten, in the Constitution of the State of Alabama.
