

Lile M^t & L^s 25.00 - Page's Store Ala June 28th 1828

To On the first day of November next we or either
 Jas H Page of us promise to pay to the order of J H Page the
 sum of twenty five dollars at his store in said
 County for value received in necessary provisions
 and money to purchase the same advanced by
 him to us for the purpose of enabling us to make
 a crop for the current year. This advance was
 obtained "bona fide" for the purpose of enabling
 us to make a crop, and without such advances it
 would not have been in the power of said W H,
 Lile & Asa Goodwin Jr to procure the necessary
 teams provisions and farming implements to make
 a crop the present year, for consideration of which
 hereby grant to said J H Page a lien on all
 crops grown in our plantations, in Shelby County
 Alabama, and waive the right of exception
 under the laws of Alabama, as provided for in
 section 7 Article 1 in the Constitution of the State
 of Alabama.
